One program for a **clinic with its own pharmacy** — appointments, consultations, prescriptions, dispensing, stock and the day's money.

WHAT IT NEEDS

One **Windows PC**, a printer, and nothing else. **No internet** for the daily work. A spare TV if you want a waiting-room screen.

WHAT IT COSTS

One payment, one clinic. No monthly or yearly charge. Installation, training and the first month of support are free.

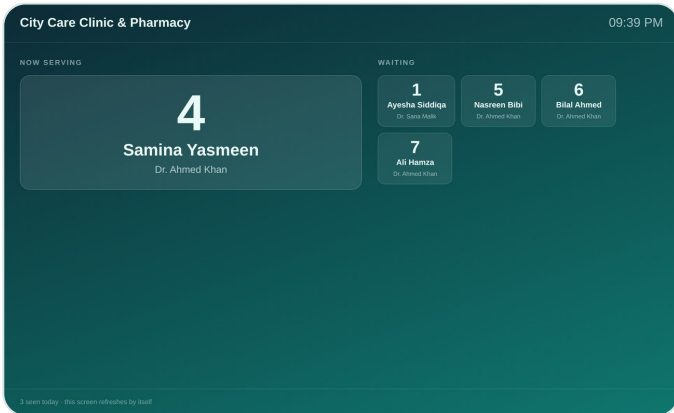

The waiting-room screen calling the next token

The queue, not a shouting match

Every patient gets a token and a place in line, and the screen on the wall calls them in — so nobody crowds the door asking whose turn it is.

- **Book in seconds**

Search by phone or name, pick the doctor, take the fee, print the slip.

- **A token and a status**

Booked, waiting, vitals done, with doctor, finished — the desk sees the whole floor at once.

- **The waiting-room screen**

Now serving and who is next. Put an old TV in the corridor; it runs itself.

- **Fees, and what is still due**

Taken now or left on the account — and the balance follows the patient.

- **Duplicates found for you**

The same person entered twice on two phone numbers is flagged, not multiplied.

Everything on one screen

A doctor should not be hunting through tabs while a patient waits. Vitals, history, examination, diagnosis and the prescription are one page.

Vitals

BP, pulse, temperature, weight, height, SpO₂ and sugar — typed once, kept for ever.

Prescribe by name

A few letters finds the medicine; set dose, frequency, days and the instruction.

Pharmacy or dispensary, per line

Say which, and the counter knows exactly what to hand over.

Private notes the patient never sees

Kept with the visit, off the printed prescription.

Follow-up date

Set it here and it comes back on the day it is due.

The pharmacy counter, mid-sale

Batch, expiry, and what it really cost

A clinic pharmacy loses money quietly — in expired strips, and in a cost nobody wrote down. This keeps both in front of you.

- Every batch separately**
 Its own expiry and its own purchase price, so the profit figure is the true one.
- Expiry before it bites**
 What expires this month, and what already has, on the dashboard.
- A counter built for speed**
 Scan or type; F-keys for discount, payment mode and exact cash. Save and print.
- The prescription is already there**
 Written in the room a minute ago — nothing is typed twice.
- Purchases and suppliers**
 What you bought, from whom, at what price, and what is left of it.

What should be in the drawer

Consultation fees, pharmacy sales, refunds and what went out — then you count the cash, and the system tells you the difference.

■ Daily collection

Fees and pharmacy side by side, by payment mode, exportable to Excel.

■ Pharmacy profit

Revenue, cost of goods and margin — day by day, with the top medicines.

■ Balances

Who owes what, without going through the register.

■ Day close

Expected against counted, with the difference recorded and a note for why.

Owner

Reception

Booking, tokens and fees. Not the clinical notes.

Pharmacist

The counter, stock, batches, purchases and suppliers.

Dispenser

The dispensing queue and nothing that touches money.

It is a clinic system, not a hospital one. No wards, no admissions, no operation theatre. If you need those, ask us about the hospital system instead.

The licence covers one clinic. A second branch needs its own licence.

Patient records sit on your computer. Take the backup — it is one button — and keep it on a USB or in Drive.

The screens are in English. Prescriptions and receipts print with your clinic's name and address on them.

The audit trail cannot be switched off. That is deliberate — it is the part that protects you.

The patient portal needs internet. Everything else does not.
